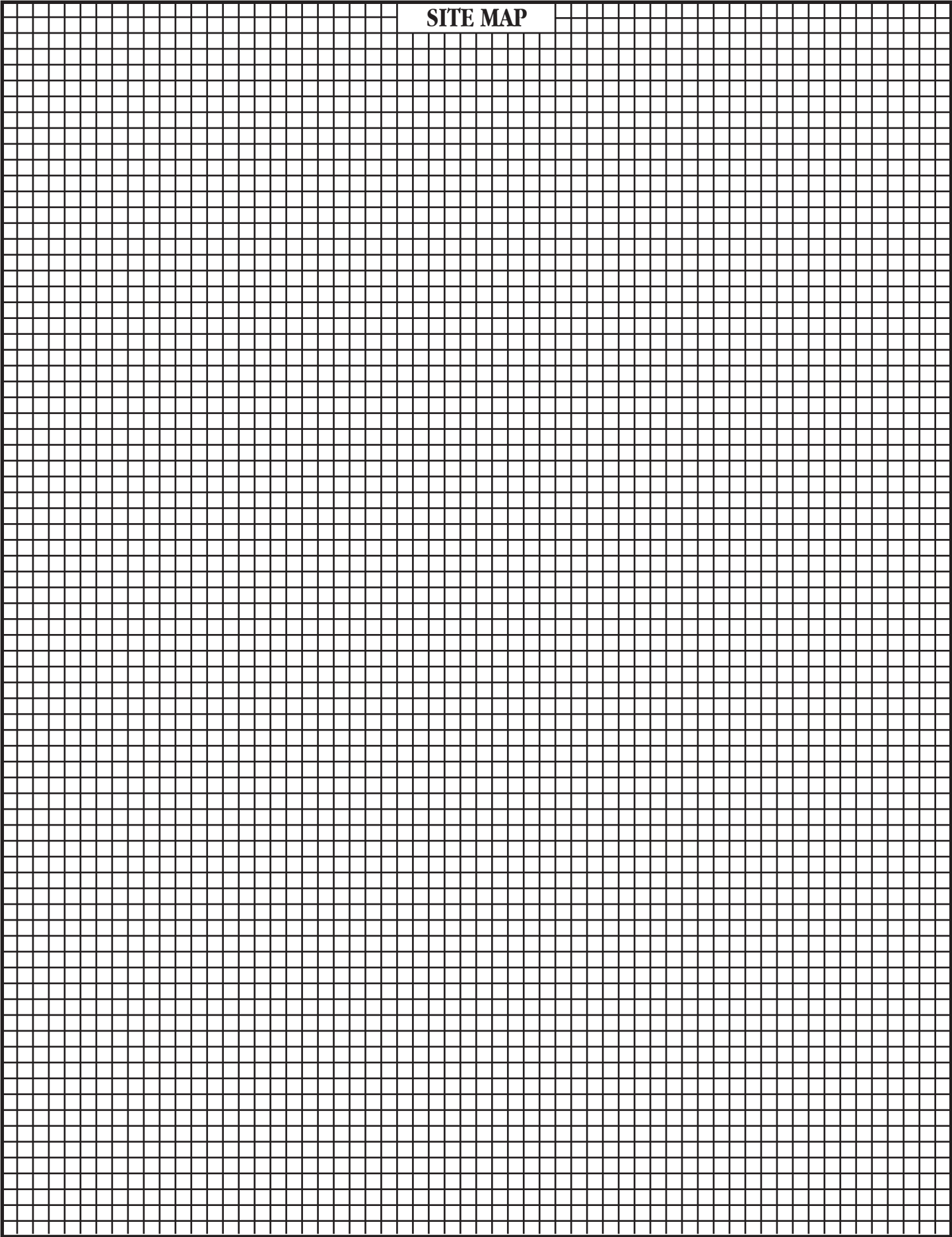

BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATION GUIDE

Before you submit your project, did you provide:

- Project plans
- Detailed sitemap including:
 - Lot lines with dimensions in feet
 - Locations of all driveways, roads, or rights of way
 - Locations of all wells, septic systems or sewer lines
 - Distance in feet to all shorelines, wetlands, shoreland zones, streams, or brooks
 - Any existing structures, dwellings, out buildings, decks, or exterior stairs including dimensions
 - Proposed structures, additions, or changes including dimensions
 - Areas to be filled or graded
 - Areas to be cleared or trees removed
 - Methods and locations of erosion control if needed
- Planning Board approval (if required for your project)

If you are in the shoreland zone, did you provide:

- DEP Erosion Control Certificate for your contractor (if using a contractor)
- Erosion control plan

Please note, if working in the shoreland zone, you may need a DEP Permit in addition to the town's permit. Also, please note that the building permit does not cover any plumbing or septic work. You will need separate permits for those actions.
