APPLICATION INFORMATION FOR FINANCIAL AID/SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

The Town of Warren Scholarship Committee has the following awards available. Students can apply for any or all of these scholarships with a single application. Please see the Medomak Valley High School Guidance Office or Heather at the Town of Warren with any questions.

The application DEADLINE for all scholarships on this list is MAY 1st. Please submit completed application to Heather at the Warren Town Office by email bookkeeper@warrenmaine.org, mail or drop off at the office.

CYRUS EATON SCHOLARSHIP

It is the intent of the Committee to recommend awards to candidates of the Town of Warren whose parents or legal guardians who have resided in the Town of Warren for the last two (2) full years of high school. Any post-secondary school applicant who has met the previous requirements must be a legal resident of the Town of Warren for at least one (1) year prior to submitting the application.

This scholarship is renewable and can be awarded up to four (4) years.

SARAH E. HILT HIGH SCHOOL ENDOWMENT FUND

Awards will be given to candidates of the Town of Warren who, with their parent (s) or legal guardian (s), will have resided in the Town of Warren for the last two (2) years of high school.

Graduating high school seniors are eligible for this scholarship.

EDWARD LEMKE SCHOLARSHIP

The income of the fund shall be used to award an annual scholarship to a deserving student who is a resident of the Town of Warren and a graduate of the district high school of which the Town of Warren may be a part of.

Graduating high school seniors are eligible for this scholarship.

LELAND E. OVERLOCK SCHOLARSHIP

The income of the fund shall be used to award an annual scholarship to a deserving student who is a resident of the Town of Warren and a graduate of the district high school of which the Town of Warren may be a part of.

Graduating high school seniors are eligible for this scholarship.

BRYAN and PHYLLIS ROBINSON SCHOLARSHIP

The income of the fund shall be used to award an annual scholarship to a deserving student who is a resident of the Town of Warren for four (4) years and a graduate of the district high school of which the Town of Warren may be a part of. The scholarship shall be used by said student to promote his or her higher education at a college or university.

Graduating high school seniors are eligible for this scholarship.

FRANK and GERTRUDE ROWE SCHOLARSHIP

The income of the fund shall be used to award an annual scholarship to a deserving student who is a resident of the Town of Warren and a graduate of the district high school of which the Town of Warren may be a part of.

Graduating high school seniors are eligible for this scholarship.

WARREN DAY COMMITTEE SCHOLARSHIP

The Warren Day Committee Scholarship is available to a Warren student, who attended Medomak Valley High School for the entire senior year, graduated in the current or preceding year and enrolled in a college for the first time. The student must be in enrolled or accepted into a recognized post-secondary course of study.

Graduating high school seniors are eligible for this scholarship. Please complete the statement at the bottom of the application form.
