The Knox County Sheriff's Office reports calls for service for the 3rd Quarter. The total calls were 685 with 36 adult arrest. There were 27 crashes and 151 car stops. There were 8 domestic assault calls and 3 overdoses.

Public Works cleaned up some downed trees on the Mountain Road and the wood was left on site. They started some brush cutting on the Tolman Road.

Ambulance Revenue for the Month of September was \$15,272.
