**Speed on the Oyster River Road:** A resident complained about the speed on the Oyster River Road. I contacted the Knox County Sherriff Office. They have placed the mobile radar speed sign and will be monitoring the traffic on the Oyster River Road.

We had started the ditching on High St. the week prior but it was not completed until this week due to the lack of manpower to conduct work zone safety procedures.
