Safety Meeting: There were no incidents or accidents to review this month. We discussed the recent storm clean up and how well the new chipper worked. I am currently waiting to meet with FEMA Official who are here this week to go over Form 7 that I submitted for reimbursement clean-up. We are starting our online safety training with blood borne pathogens.

Public Works has been placing hot mix on driveway entrances where we replaced culverts this summer. Poirier Guideline did the line striping this week on recently paved roads. Ambulance Revenue for the month of October was \$9,400. Great Job!

Automatic Foreclosures: We sent out over 70 notices this week. This has been the average number for the notices in past years.
