SUBJECT: Manager's Report

**Transfer Station** reports \$4,291.00 in revenue during the month of August with Demo at \$1,714.00 and Small Trash bags at \$1,490.00. The brush pile was burned this week and has been opened for your storm clean up debris. Thanks for the help public works!

**Code Enforcement:** Melody reports one single family dwelling permit was issues in October, 2 decks and a new garage. The planning board met on October 12<sup>th</sup> and approved the application for Virginia LaFlamme to establish Warren Massage Works at 384 Main Street. Daniel Cellucci's application was also approved to establish a farm to grow organic certified products and medical cannabis at 358 Atlantic Highway.

**Public Works** was busy early Monday on storm debris clean up across the roads. The debris that has power lines running through it will not be touched by anyone until declared safe by CMP. All plow trucks have passed inspection with Truck #1 needing some work. Brad Beverage has been hired full-time and Donald Holbrook has come back as a seasonal driver.

**Fire Department** was out helping with the posting of Road Closure Signs for those roads with trees and power lines down on them. For those without power, please be careful when burning candles and using your generator. **Chief Andrews and the Warren Fire Department** was awarded **\$2,000** from the MMA Safety Enhancement Grant. The chief wrote this grant for Overhead Door Openers. Improving workplace safety for employees save the taxpayers money by reducing lost hours at work, cost of insurance claims etc.

**Board of Selectmen Workshop** is scheduled for Tuesday November 21<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. at the Warren Town Office. The Workshop is with DEP, Bill Longfellow the Project Manager for the Rifle Range Project.

**Ambulance** responded to 33 emergency calls for the month of October. Kevin Montoya will be leaving on November 6<sup>th</sup> to work for the City of Westbrook as a paramedic on the Fire Department but will still work some shifts here in Warren.
