SUBJECT: Manager's Report

Reginal School Unit Tax Assessment for the Town of Warren is \$3,950,223.00 which is an increase of \$82,473.00 from last year.

Public Works has done some repair work this week at Riverside Cemetery and ditching continues on Western Road.

Flowers were donated to the Town Office by Jan & Fred MacDonald of Barley Jo Greenhouse. The flower beds were prepared by Public Works and the flowers were planted by Jan & Fred. Thank You! Pictures were taken and placed on the website by Melissa.

Code Enforcement: Melody was notified this week she passed her Internal Plumbing test. Melody issued a permit for a commercial addition at 316 Carroll Road. The Planning Board approved the new 6,300 square foot convenience store that will replace the 3,000 square foot Ande's variety.

During **Town Meeting** this week, 72 Warren residents passed all 37 articles. Bill Lufkin was given a plaque for his dedicated years of service on the Board of Selectmen. The code officer and recreation director positions are now fulltime positions. The Sandy Shores Smart Stream culvert project was approved under Capital Improvement. It was voted to prohibit Marijuana Commercial activities that include processing facilities, retail stores, social clubs and cultivation facilities.

During the Board of Selectmen's Meeting on 6/21/17, Wayne Luce was elected Chair and Roger Peabody, Vice Chair. The Board voted to approve the purchase of 6 park grills for Payson Park and Justin Hills was appointed to be the Shellfish Warden starting July 1st.

The 2017 Annual Alewife Harvesting Report shows 4,477 bushel were harvested for the St. George River. The total revenue is \$111,925 with the towns share of 40% at \$44,770 Last years report 2016 shows 3,590 bushel with the town's revenue at \$35,900. Great Job Dana and Robert!
