SUBJECT: Manager's Report

Alewives Extension has been granted from June 5 to June 15, 2017 by Patrick Keliher, Commissioner of the Department of Marine Resources. The Alewives Report for June 2nd showed the Town's revenue for that week at \$12,470.

Monthly Expense report shows us at 87% with the month of June left to close out the fiscal year. The **revenues** shows us at 116.77% collected.

Ambulance Revenue for the month of May is at \$9,399.35

Transfer Station Revenues for the month of May is \$4,246.00 with Demolition Debris at \$1,713.75 and Trash bags at \$1,340.00. David and Ralph attended DEP Transfer Station operations which was held in Augusta.

Fire Department responded to 10 calls for the month of May. There were 3 car accidents with one being a double fatal. There were 26 burn permits issued in May.

Library News: 22 children took part in the Adopt a pet rock to read to. 5 people took part in the Get Fit Challenge. 322 adults and 199 children used the Library for the month of May.

Code Enforcements: Building permits were issued for two single family dwellings, 7 accessory structures and 3 demolition permits. Plumbing permits were issued for 2 new septic systems, 1 replacement, 1 modular and one mobile food truck for the month of May.
